This is not a holiday either but it is widely observed. While you may see displays of dolls in traditional garb, families usually observe the day quietly in the home.



Obon is an annual event that is derived from Buddhist belief that one's deceased ancestors' spirits return to earth to visit their living descendants from the 13th to the 15th day of the 7th month of the year.







#### **Silver Week**

#### Third weekend in September - Silver Week

A new arrangement as of 2009 that moved one holiday and created a new one to enable a 5-day weekend.

Third Monday - Keiro no Hi - Respect for the Aged Day. This day honours Japan's elderly and shows respect for their longevity. It was established to commemorate the enactment of the law concerning Welfare for the Aged.

22 Sept Tuesday - Kokumin no Kyujitsu. A new hollday dedicated to all gapan as a group.



### **Sports Day**

#### 2nd Monday in October - Taiiku no Hi - Sports Day

People enthusiastically celebrate good physical and mental health through physical activity on this day. This holiday was established to commemorate the Tokyo Summer Olympics of 1964. Schools will hold races and other forms of competition in which all students participate and entire families attend and sometimes take part in some of the events.





#### **Labor Thanksgiving Day**

23 November - Kinro Kansha no Hi - Labor Thanksgiving Day

On this day, people traditionally express gratitude to each other for the blessing that their labours have produced and for the fruits of that labor.
